APPROVING ACCEPTANCE OF A \$300,000 IOWA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES (DNR) RESOURCE ENHANCEMENT AND PROTECTION (REAP) GRANT FOR THE DES MOINES RIVER TRAIL, PHASE I

WHEREAS, the Park and Recreation Department is responsible for the development of trails; and

WHEREAS, the Park and Recreation Department applied for a DNR REAP grant for the purpose of constructing the Des Moines River Trail, Phase I; and

WHEREAS, the Des Moines River Trail, Phase I will stretch from the Meredith Trail at the Scott Street Bridge, along the Des Moines River, to the James W. Cownie Soccer and Baseball Parks; and

WHEREAS, the DNR has provided a grant agreement, a copy of which is on file in the City Clerk's Office; and

WHEREAS, the grant provides up to \$300,000 to be put toward development costs; and

WHEREAS, the grant agreement specifies that the work in the project proposal must be completed by December 31, 2011; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to accept this grant award from the DNR;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the above described DNR REAP grant award is accepted, said agreement is approved, and the Mayor is authorized and directed to sign said agreement on behalf of the City and the City Clerk is directed to attest to his signature.

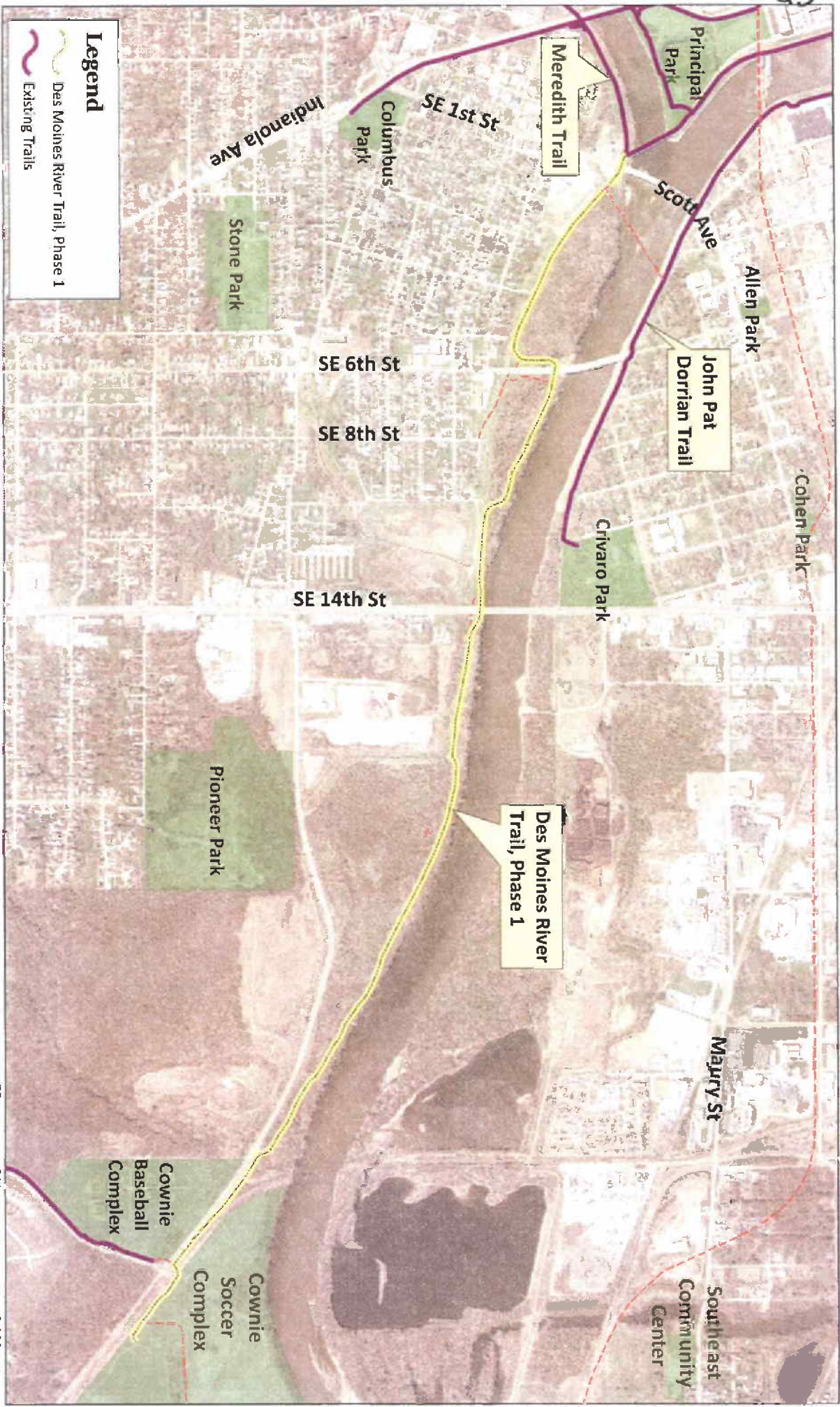
