APPROVING EXTENSION OF TIME TO COMPLY WITH RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT

WHEREAS, Rudolph Simms, Jr., became employed by the City of Des Moines in August, 2006, in a position in which he is required to comply with the City residency requirement contained in Des Moines Code Section 2-486 within 7 months of employment; and

WHEREAS, Rudolph Simms, Jr. entered into a contract for the construction of a personal residence in the City of Des Moines, scheduled to be completed in time for his compliance with the City residency requirement, but due to no fault of Mr. Simms, the construction delays have moved the tentative completion date to a time after City residency is required under Section 2-486; and


WHEREAS, in the past the City Council has extended the time for compliance with the residency requirement where the need to do so was created by extenuating circumstances.
