
To The Honorable Members of the Des Moines City Council:

Please accept this letter as a request on behalf of my client—Barton A. Hicklin—to waive the three readings of the request for vacation and conveyance by the Des Moines City Council. The addresses of the adjoining affected properties are attached hereto. The waiver is requested due to the fact that Mr. Hicklin has been engaged in the process of attempting to acquire these properties from the City of Des Moines for more than one year and has expended substantial sums of money in so doing. Additionally, when the initial request was made by Mr. Hicklin to vacate and convey the streets and alley rights-of-way, notice was given—and consent in writing obtained from—all affected public property owners. The notices and consents are in the City's file. Consequently, the three readings by the Council would be duplicative and unnecessarily time consuming for all involved.
