> WHEREAS, on December 18, 2006, by Roll Call No. 06-2481, the City Council approved the PUD Restoration Bond for the Drake-Hubbell Housing development, located in the vicinity of 31st Street and Carpenter Avenue and accepted PUD Restoration Bond #IAC73839 from Merchant's Bonding Company, in the amount of \$41,287 as security for the estimated cost of completing the required grading and site restoration for such development project; and,

> WHEREAS, the City Engineer and Community Development Director have certified that the required grading and site restoration have been satisfactorily completed and recommend that the security in the amount of \$41,287 for such improvements be released and returned to the developer; NOW THEREFORE.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, as follows:

- 1. That PUD Restoration Bond #IAC73839 in the amount of \$41,287 from Hubbell Realty Company, and Merchant's Bonding Company, is hereby released as security for the satisfactory completion of the required grading and site restoration, and shall be returned to the Principal.
