ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Des Moines Park and Recreation Board recommends that the above fee structure be adopted for Park and Recreation ball fields. The above fees have not been adjusted for at least the past ten years and are designed to aid in supporting the overall Athletics and Sports Tourism operation.

Tournament rental fees would include dragging and lining at the beginning of each day and every two games or as determined by the Park and Recreation Supervisor and Head Grounds Keeper, depending on the number of games, location, and facility. Tournament directors would be allowed to drag and line between games at the discretion of the Park and Recreation Supervisor and Heads Grounds Keeper. For additional dragging and lining of fields, the fee would be \$15.00 per field per lining.

The City of West Des Moines charges \$65.00 per field per day for their ball fields, plus an additional \$25.00 per hour for lights. This fee only provides one dragging/lining in the morning. Additional maintenance fees are negotiated based on the number of teams and requested maintenance levels. Since these fees are new to the Des Moines Park and Recreation Department, staff is recommending \$15.00 per hour for League use, including games and practices. This is at a higher rate than neighborhood practices because the participants are being charged a league fee to a private operator for use of public facilities. The adult baseball rate is recommended to match the neighborhood rate because this service is not currently being provided in the community. The City has a long-term relationship with the Des Moines Semi-Pro Baseball League, and they have invested in Birdland Baseball Field over the years.

If a tournament director chooses to sell products or services at a City venue as a part of their event, the City's ordinance related to concession sales would apply based on the venue chosen. There are additional limitations on products being sold as the City has Concessionaire / Lease Agreements at Cownie Baseball, Greater Des Moines and Savage Softball, with the City receiving a percentage of gross sales.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines,
Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000,
and amended by Ordinance No. 13,929 passed March 12, 2001, and
Ordinance No. 14,315 passed February 9, 2004 is hereby amended by
amending Section 74-176 relating to ball diamond fees, as follows:
Sec. 74-176. Ball diamonds, tennis, volleyball court and soccer
fields.

- (a) Scope. Fees for use of city ball diamonds, volleyball courts and soccer fields and for tennis shall be as provided in this section.
- (b) Ball diamonds. Fees for use of ball diamonds for private use at Carney, Chesterfield, Savage, Stone, Birdland, Cownie Baseball Park and Greater Des Moines Softball Park. No charge for educational institutions.
- (<u>c</u>b) Ball diamonds. Fees for use of ball diamonds for private use <u>at Carney, Chesterfield, Savage, Stone, Birdland, Cownie</u>
 Baseball Park and Greater Des Moines Softball Park, with each session lasting one hour, shall be as follows:
 - (1) Tournament Field Rental \$65.00 per field per day
 - (2) Tournament Field Rental after 5:00 p.m. \$35.00 per field per day
- (3) Tournament fees include lining and chalking every three games. Each additional line and chalk \$15.00 per field per lining
- (4) Tournament Admission fee: \$50.00 per team when admissions fees or advanced fees are charged as a part of the tournament registration
- (5) Rental for Games and Practices (Leagues) \$15.00 per hour before 6:00 pm
- (6) Rental for Games and Practices (Leagues) \$25.00 per hour
