ORDINANCE NO	

AN ORDINANCE vacating the West 16.5 feet of South Union adjoining 5 Park Avenue.

WHEREAS, all prior requirements of law pertaining to the vacation of public right-of-way have been fully observed; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the public right-of-way herein described be vacated;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the West 16.5 feet of South Union adjoining 5 Park Avenue, more specifically described as follows, be and is hereby vacated.

Except the South 15.0 feet, the West 16.5 feet of the East 33.5 feet of Lot 1, Smith and McClurg's Place, an Official Plat, all now included in and forming a part of the City of Des Moines, Polk County, Iowa.

Sec. 2. The City of Des Moines hereby reserves an easement upon the property described above for the continued use and maintenance of any utilities now in place, with the right of entry for servicing same.
