

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS,

PUBLIC WORKS' SERVICES PROVIDED IN OUR COMMUNITY ARE AN INTEGRAL PART OF OUR CITIZENS' EVERYDAY LIVES; AND

WHEREAS,

THE SUPPORT OF AN UNDERSTANDING AND INFORMED CITIZENRY IS VITAL TO THE EFFICIENT OPERATION OF PUBLIC WORKS' SERVICES AND MAINTENANCE PROGRAMS SUCH AS SANITATION, SEWERS, STREETS, FORESTRY, AND WASTEWATER RECLAMATION; AND

WHEREAS,

THE PROTECTION AND PRESERVATION OF THE AREA'S NATURAL RESOURCES FOR THE
BENEFIT OF FUTURE GENERATIONS DEPENDS ON THE SUSTAINABILITY OF THESE
SERVICES AND PROGRAMS; AND

WHEREAS,
THE QUALITY AND EFFECTIVENESS OF THESE FUNCTIONS, AS WELL AS THEIR PLANNING,
DESIGN, AND CONSTRUCTION, IS VITALLY DEPENDENT UPON THE EFFORTS AND SKILL OF
PUBLIC WORKS AND ENGINEERING OFFICIALS; AND

THE EFFICIENCY OF THE QUALIFIED AND DEDICATED PERSONNEL WHO STAFF THE DEPARTMENTS OF PUBLIC WORKS AND ENGINEERING IS MATERIALLY INFLUENCED BY THE PEOPLE'S ATTITUDE AND UNDERSTANDING OF THE IMPORTANCE OF THE WORK THEY PERFORM.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, T. M. FRANKLIN COWNIE, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY COUNCIL AND THE CITIZENS OF DES MOINES, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF MAY 16 – 22, 2010, AS:
