EXTENSION OF THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT OF DES MOINES CODE SECTION 2-486 FOR TEMPORARY COMMUNITY SERVICES NON-CIVIL SERVICE EMPLOYEES FOR THE DURATION OF THE COMMUNITY SERVICES BLOCK GRANT AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT (CSBG ARRA) GRANT

WHEREAS, in the fall of 2009, the Community Services Division of the Community Development Department hired temporary full-time Family Development Specialists to provide coordination, record keeping, and services to citizens of the City during the period of the Community Services Block Grant American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (CSBG ARRA) funding, three of whom live outside of the City of Des Moines limits; and


WHEREAS, the job classification of these temporary full-time employees is one which requires the employees to comply with the City residency requirement contained in Des Moines Code Section 2-486 within seven (7) months of employment; and

WHEREAS, in the past the City Council has extended the time for compliance with the residency requirement.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the date for the three non-City resident temporary full-time Family Development Specialists hired by the Community Services Division of the Community Development Department to demonstrate compliance with the residency requirement under Des Moines Code Section 2-486 be extended through September 30, 2010.
