Support for 28E Agreement by and between the Neighborhood RE: Finance Corporation, City of Des Moines and Polk County

Dear Mayor Cownie and Honorable Council Members,

The Neighborhood Finance Corporation (NFC) has been an invaluable non-profit lending institution since 1989. They have been a part of rebuilding our neighborhoods house by house and also a part of the revitalization of downtown housing. They have expanded their expertise to offer the tool lending library, new home-owner education, and become a direct seller of loans to Fannie Mae.

The City and County funding of the NFC has resulted in the NFC assisting over 26,000 units of housing with over \$144 million of loans and grants in the years since they were incorporated. The loans and grants have been provided for rehabilitation and construction of singlefamily homes as well as assistance for rehabilitation and construction of multi-family units.

At its meeting on May 2, 2007, the Neighborhood Revitalization Board recommended that the City Council and the Polk County Board of Supervisors approve the new 28E agreement and to each provide \$1 million annually to the NFC until 2010 with two additional one year renewals until June 30, 2012.
