RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO SCHEDULE A
COUNCIL WORK SESSION REGARDING VEHICLE DISPLAY LOTS
AND
EXTENDING THE TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON THE CREATION
AND EXPANSION OF VEHICLE DISPLAY LOTS

WHEREAS, on March 24, 2008, by Roll Call No. 08-510A, the City Council imposed a temporary moratorium through June 23, 2008, on the creation or expansion of vehicle display lots at any location within the City of Des Moines that is zoned to the "C-2" General Retail and Highway Oriented Commercial District, to maintain the status quo until additional regulations and guidelines are established to better regulate how vehicle display lots are designed and operated in the "C-2" District; and,


WHEREAS, on June 22, 2008, by Roll Call No. 08-1145, the City Council continued the moratorium until August 26, 2008, in response to the flooding that occurred in the City of Des Moines and the need for the City Staff to focus upon the recovery efforts; and,

WHEREAS, on August 25 the City Council passed Ordinance No. 14,795 prohibiting the parking of vehicles in violation of an approved site plan, and restricting the resumption of nonconforming uses such as nonconforming vehicle display lots after a temporary discontinuance of such use, but such Ordinance did not fully resolve the City Council's concerns regarding the appearance and operation of vehicle display lots and the impact of vehicle display lots upon the existing and planned uses of adjoining property; and,

WHEREAS, on August 25, 2008, by Roll Call No. 08-1533, on November 10, 2008, by Roll Call No. 08-2010, and on March 9, 2009, by Roll Call No. 09-430, the City Council continued the moratorium until June 9, 2009, to allow time for the review and consideration of further amendments to the Zoning Ordinance or Site Plan Regulations to address the City Council's concerns regarding the appearance and impacts of vehicle display lots; and,

WHEREAS, the Community Development Department has proposed an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance to create a "VDL" Vehicle Display Lot Overlay District to be applied to those portions of E. 14th Street, SE 14th Street and E. University Avenue currently zoned to the "C-2" General Retail and Highway Oriented Commercial District, as further described in the accompanying Council Communication; and,

WHEREAS, a continuance of the temporary moratorium on the approval of site plans for the construction or expansion of vehicle display lots is necessary and appropriate to maintain the status quo and to prevent new development from occurring before the City Council has an opportunity to consider adoption of the proposed amendment to the Zoning Ordinance and the proposed rezoning as described above; and,


BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council for the City of Des Moines, Iowa, as follows:
