ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE vacating a portion of 14<sup>th</sup> Place from Ascension Street to Keosauqua Way.

WHEREAS, all prior requirements of law pertaining to the vacation of public right-of-way have been fully observed; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the public right-of-way herein described be vacated;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That a portion of 14<sup>th</sup> Place from Ascension Street to Keosauqua Way, more specifically described as follows, be and is hereby vacated.

All of 14<sup>th</sup> Place right-of-way lying West of and adjoining Lot 117, Keosauqua Way Plat No. 4, an Official Plat, and lying West of and adjoining Lots 41 thru 45, Loughery's Addition, an Official Plat, all now included in and forming a part of the City of Des Moines, Polk County, Iowa.


Sec. 2. The City of Des Moines hereby reserves an easement upon the property described above for the continued use and maintenance of any utilities now in place, with the right of entry for servicing same.

Sec. 3. That the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause certified copies of this ordinance and proof of publication thereof together with proof of publication of the notice of the public hearing on this matter to be properly filed in the office of the Recorder of Polk County, Iowa.
