ORDERING CONSTRUCTION OF MCKINLEY AVENUE DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS - S.W. 26TH/S.W. 31ST STREETS AND FIXING A DATE FOR RECEIVING OF BIDS ON JULY 14, 2009 AND PUBLIC HEARING ON JULY 27, 2009 ENGINEER'S ESTIMATE IS \$313,476.50

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA: That the attached communication recommending construction of the following improvement and the method of financing; and also including the recommendation of the Des Moines City Engineer, as the Jurisdictional Engineer, submitting plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and Jurisdictional Engineer's estimate of cost for the construction of the following improvement:

McKinley Avenue Drainage Improvements - S.W. 26th/S.W. 31st Streets, 08-2009-006

The improvement includes approximately 6800 CY of excavation, 267.5 LF of 18" storm sewer, 181.4 LF of 18" storm sewer augered-in-place, associated storm sewer manholes and intakes, PCC driveway removal and replacement, driveway culverts, sod, and miscellaneous associated work including clean up; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 483-119/123, located along the north side of the 2700 block of McKinley Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa



Proposals received will be opened at a public meeting presided over by the Jurisdictional Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa, at 11:00 a.m. on July 14, 2009, after which the bids together with a bid tabulation and recommendation of the Jurisdictional Engineer will be presented to the City Council at its next meeting for action thereon.
