AUTHORIZATION TO SUBMIT CDBG DISASTER RECOVERY INFRASTRUCTURE APPLICATIONS TO THE IOWA DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ON BEHALF OF THE DES MOINES WASTEWATER RECLAMATION AUTHORITY.

Whereas, on May 19, 2009, under WRA Board Resolution Number 09-75, the WRA Board authorized the WRA Board Chairperson and WRA Board Secretary to execute and attest, respectively, CDBG Disaster Recovery Infrastructure Applications for and on behalf of the Des Moines Metropolitan Wastewater Reclamation Authority for two projects being:

- Des Moines Metropolitan Wastewater Reclamation Authority (WRA) Main Outfall Replacement, Phase 17, Segment 1 Project,
- Des Moines Metropolitan Wastewater Reclamation Authority (WRA) Southwest Area Diversion Facility Pump Station, Phase 22, Segment 5 (Frisbee Park) Project,

and submit said applications to the Iowa Department of Economic Development, and

Whereas, the City Engineer submitted said applications to the Iowa Department of Economic Development and was told that only cities and counties could apply for CDBG Disaster Recovery Infrastructure funding; however, the City of Des Moines (City) could submit the applications on behalf of the WRA and if funds were awarded, the City and WRA could enter into a sub recipient agreement to transfer the funds and responsibilities from the City to the WRA, and

Whereas, the WRA Director has submitted the attached letter requesting that the CDBG Disaster Recovery Infrastructure Applications as approved by the WRA Board be modified to be approved and submitted by the Des Moines City Council on behalf of the WRA Board, and

Whereas, Mr. Hank Manning, Iowa Department of Economic Development, has indicated that the Des Moines City Council can submit these CDBG Disaster Recovery Infrastructure Applications on behalf of the WRA Board, and


