Dear Diane, As part of our Centennial Celebration, The Rotary Club of Des Moines would respectfully request an honorary street name of "ROTARY WAY" to the existing 12<sup>th</sup> Street between Grand and Locust Street. This is located near the area where our Club previously donated \$40,000 worth of trees to the City of Des Moines.

We would like to have the ceremony of this honorary street naming occur the first week in May of 2011. We are working on proclaiming the week of May 1-7, 2011 "The Rotary Club of Des Moines Centennial Week" by the City and State of Iowa.

The Rotary Club of Des Moines was organized on May 1, 1911 as the first Rotary Club in Iowa and number 27 in the world out of 33,000 clubs worldwide. There are currently more than 350 members of The Rotary Club of Des Moines.

We would request The Rotary Club of Des Moines be placed on the City Council agenda on June 28<sup>th</sup> to be granted permission for this honorary street name.

I understand it is our responsibility to pay for the actual sign. Can you provide me with the cost, please?
