RESOLUTION CONTINUING HEARING ON APPLICATION OF KATHLEEN KIRSCHBAUM FOR REZONING OF 2713 MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. PARKWAY

WHEREAS, on May 19, 2008, by Roll Call No. 08-872, the City Council scheduled a public hearing to be held on June 9, 2008, at 5:00 p.m., on the application of Kathleen Kirschbaum (owner) to rezone property located at 2713 Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway, from Limited "C-2" General Retail and Highway Oriented Commercial and "M-3" Limited Industrial, to a Limited "M-1" Light Industrial District; and,

WHEREAS, on June 9, 2008, by Roll Call No. 08-1045, the City Council approved a request by the applicant Kathleen Kirschbaum to continue the public hearing on the rezoning until June 23, 2008, to allow additional time for discussions with the City Staff regarding the appropriate conditions to be placed upon the future use and development of the property, and,

WHEREAS, on June 23, 2008, by Roll Call No. 08-1125, the City Council continued the hearing until July 14, 2008, in response to the temporary evacuation of City Hall; and,

WHEREAS, the applicant and City staff are engaged in continuing discussions regarding certain zoning enforcement issues and the wording of proposed zoning conditions which should be resolved before proceeding with the public hearing on the requested rezoning.
