AMENDING FIRE DEPARTMENT SCHEDULE OF FEES TO DELETE ALARM MONITORING SERVICE FEES

WHEREAS, on July 9, 2007, by Roll Call Number 07-1353, City Council approved the discontinuance of fire alarm monitoring services of private and public properties by the Des Moines Fire Department communications center and the deletion of reference to the alarm monitoring services provided under Section 46-1(e) of the Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, on _____, 2007, by Roll Call Number _____, City Council approved an ordinance deleting Section 46-1(e) of the Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the current Fire Department Schedule of Fees includes fees for alarm user monitoring and maintenance related to the alarm monitoring services previously provided under the deleted Section 46-1(e) of the Municipal Code, which fees should now be deleted from the Schedule of Fees; and

WHEREAS, an amended Fire Department Schedule of Fees has been prepared for Council consideration and is recommended for adoption, which Schedule of Fees is appended hereto and is now on file in the Office of the City Clerk.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA, that the Fire Department Schedule of Fees as amended and appended hereto is hereby approved and adopted;

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said Fire Department Schedule of Fees shall be maintained on file in the Office of the City Clerk for public reference, and that the amendments therein established shall become effective upon and as of the day following this City Council Meeting.
