I am unable to attend today's Council Meeting and speak regarding the item on Hoppers Bar, so I am sending this letter instead.

I have lived in my home at 2512 Boyd St. for over 34 years, which is a few blocks south of the bar. I have and still enjoy living in the Fairmount Park Neighborhood and want it to remain a good place to live.

The area is close to the library, schools, parks, golf course, aquatic center, and shopping for everyday needs. The area is served well by grocery, banking, food service, specialty needs, and other commercial services in the commercial area at East Euclid Ave. and East 25th Street.

However, the commercial area includes Hoppers Bar which is disturbing to the adjacent properties and the surrounding area. The problems that the neighbors and businesses have endured are not right. The rights of the bar should not be greater than those of the neighborhood. They have been a nuisance far to long and need to be declared as such. I endure the traffic noise after the bar closes in the early hours, and I am concerned about what this type of activity does to the reputation and the subsequent property values of the area.
