HOLD HEARING FOR THE CONVEYANCE OF THE VACATED EAST/WEST ALLEY RIGHT-OF-WAY BETWEEN MAHASKA AVENUE AND STATE AVENUE, EAST OF EAST 32ND STREET, TO ADJOINING PROPERTY OWNERS FOR \$150

WHEREAS, on August 7, 1995, by Roll Call No. 95-3013, the City Council approved Ordinance No. 13,219 vacating the East/West alley right-of-way between Mahaska Avenue and State Avenue, East of East 32nd Street; and

WHEREAS, the owners of property abutting such vacated right-of-way have offered to the City of Des Moines the purchase price listed below for the purchase of such City-owned property, more specifically described below; and

WHEREAS, on August 20, 2007, by Roll Call No. 07-<u><u>1591</u>, it was duly resolved by the City Council that the proposed conveyance of the vacated East/West alley right-of-way between Mahaska Avenue and State Avenue, East of East 32nd Street, be set down for hearing on September 10, 2007, at 5:00 p.m., in the City Council Chambers; and</u>

WHEREAS, due notice of said proposal to convey this public real property was given as provided by law, setting forth the time and place for hearing on said proposal; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with City Council direction, those interested in this proposed conveyance, both for and against, have been given an opportunity to be heard with respect thereto and have presented their views to the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

- 7. Upon receipt of the recorded documents back from the Polk County Recorder, the Real Estate Division Manager shall mail the originals of the Deeds and copies of the other documents to the grantees.
