## RESOLUTION APPROVING ADDITION OF KING-IRVING TRAIL SEGMENT TO MULTI-USE RECREATIONAL TRAIL MASTER PLAN MAP

WHEREAS, trail development is a very high priority with the citizens of the City of Des Moines and the Des Moines City Council; and

WHEREAS, the King-Irving Neighborhood has proposed that a trail segment to connect their neighborhood and surrounding neighborhoods into the Multi-Use Recreational Trail system be designed and constructed; and

WHEREAS, the Park and Recreation Department recommends that such trail segment be added to the City's Multi-Use Recreational Trail Master Plan Map in order that it may be included in future CIP budgets, that grants may be applied for, and that design work be done during construction of a sewer project in the area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that addition of a King-Irving trail segment to the City of Des Moines Multi-Use Recreational Trail Master Plan Map is hereby approved.


