APPROVAL OF SUPPORTIVE HOUSING PROGRAM (SHP) RENEWALGRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD)

WHEREAS, in response to a Super NOFA published in the Federal Register on March 19, 2008, to supplement funding for local homeless programs, the City's Housing Services Department prepared an application for \$3,486,015 in Continuum of Care Program funds; and

WHERAS, the application was developed from the City's Continuum of Care strategy, whereby Continuum of Care funds would provide needed services to homeless persons in Des Moines and address high priority service gaps within the parameters of the Continuum of Care-eligible activities: and

WHERAS, on September 22, 2008, by Roll Call No. 08-1660, the City Council approved the above-referenced Continuum of Care application and authorized and directed the City Manager to submit the application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

WHEREAS, HUD has now forwarded a 2008 SHP Renewal Grant Agreement for a total of \$289,732 to fund the House of Mercy Transitional Housing Program, which Agreement is on file with the City Clerk as Exhibit A and by this reference made a part hereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the above-referenced Renewal Grant Agreement by and between HUD and the City of Des Moines, whereby the City will receive a grant award of \$289,732 of 2008 SHP funding for continuation of the House of Mercy Transitional Housing Program, is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute the above-referenced Renewal Grant Agreement and the City Clerk to attest to his signature.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in order to implement the aforementioned SHP project, City staff is hereby authorized to work with the sub-recipient operating agency to develop a contract that complies with all applicable federal, state and local laws.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council authorizes and directs the City Manager to approve and execute the detailed work program and written agreement with the subrecipient entity implementing the aforementioned SHP project.
