Rahn has prepared information on Hessen Haus, Java Joes and Hickman Pub. As for the speaker on the agenda to speak in regards to Hickman Pub, I will be available at the Council Meeting to respond should it be necessary.

Rahn has indicated that he did not find any reason not to sign off on these establishments.

Dublin is also on the agenda for agenda for renewal. The last year there was 28 trips to the location. 11 for fights/disputes, 11 disturbing the peace, 1 suspicious person, 1 Intoxicated person, 4 misc. trips. There were 5 cases made with 2 arrests. They were charged with Selling alcohol to an underage person on 5-29-08 for their first offense against their liquor license and paid a 500.00 fine. Also, on 22 Oct 09 officer's of Vice/Narcotics Control Section cited Dublin's for Selling alcohol to an under aged person, they also cited one for a minor in possession of alcohol and cited four for being under aged in a bar after 9:00 PM. This is Dublin's second liquor violation that should result in another fine and a liquor license suspension when it has worked its way through the ABD process.

Information on bars for renewal.

Hessen Haus there were 20 trips to the location over the past year. 6 for fights/disputes, 4 accidents, 3 suspicious persons, 1 Intoxicated person, and 5 misc. trips. There were 8 cases made with 4 arrests. We did charge them with selling to underage person on 7-17-09. This was the first offense against their liquor license and will be handled at the Alcohol Beverage Division.

Java Joes had 38 trips to their location. 14 for fights/disputes, 5 suspicious persons 4 Intoxicated persons and 13 misc. trips. There were 12 cases made with 8 arrests.

Researching both these bars I found no reason not to sign off them.

Reference The Hickman Pub. There were 41 trips to the location over the past year. 18 for fights/disputes, 6 disturbing the peace, 2 domestics, 4 alarms on the building, 2 accidents, 2 larceny of motor vehicles, 1 shots(fired in the area outside), 6 misc. trips. There were 11 cases made with 4 arrests.
