

STAFF RECOMMENDATION TO THE P&Z COMMISSION

Staff recommends approval of the elimination of the remaining segment of West River Drive.

STAFF REPORT

I. GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Purpose of Request: The elimination of the remaining dead end segment of the park road known as West River Drive would allow future use of City owned land between University Avenue and the Center Street Dam for recreational purposes. This would be in furtherance of the "Rediscovering the Rivers" Riverfront Master Plan adopted by the City on August 25, 2003 by Roll Call No. 03-2011. The potential uses for this area include a skate park, a BMX park, a

playground, and a dog park. In addition, the existing street could be converted to a recreational trail.

- 2. Size of Site: Approximately 3,000-foot long segment of West River Drive.
- 3. Existing Zoning (site): "D-R" Downtown Riverfront District.
- 4. Existing Land Use (site): West River Drive.
- **5.** Adjacent Land Use and Zoning: "D-R" Downtown Riverfront District: The subject street passes through an open space area between the Des Moines River and 2nd Avenue.
- **6. General Neighborhood/Area Land Uses:** The subject street is located along the west bank of the Des Moines River in an area generally known as the Principal Riverwalk.
- 7. Applicable Recognized Neighborhood(s): Downtown Des Moines Neighborhood.
- 8. Relevant Zoning History: N/A.
- 9. 2020 Community Character Land Use Plan Designation: Downtown Park/Open Space.
- 10. Applicable Regulations: The Commission reviews proposals to eliminate land dedicated for a specific public purpose, such as for streets and parks, to determine whether the land is still needed for such purpose or may be released for other use. The recommendation of the Commission is forwarded to the City Council.

II. ADDITIONAL APPLICABLE INFORMATION

The City's Traffic and Transportation Division does not believe the requested elimination of the park road would adversely impact the street system since the street is currently a dead end street and does not provide access to any privately owned properties. On December 22, 2008, the City Council adopted Roll Call 08-2181 approving permanent closure of the southern 400 feet of West River Drive. This action eliminated the intersection with 2nd Avenue and caused this segment of West River Drive to become a dead end street.

SUMMARY OF DISCUSSION

Brian Millard asked for a brief presentation of Item 1.

<u>Doug Romig</u> Park and Recreation manager gave a brief overview. He also stated that he has met with all the property owners along West River Drive and 2nd Avenue adjoining the property and they have expressed full support.

Brian Millard asked about parking for the Riverwalk project.

<u>Doug Romig</u> stated they are working with Traffic and Transportation and they have indicated a desire or interest to allow parking along the 2nd Avenue weekdays after 6:00 p.m. There is also a plan for a small parking lot that is currently a gravel lot near the substation. It will become a lighted parking lot for up to 10 cars with a couple of handicap stalls that would be permanently available. Finally, there will be a parking lot off of Illinois Street for about a 100 vehicles.

<u>Jacqueline Easley</u> stated that a person being recruited at her job mentioned that the City of Des Moines seems to be family friendly city and was thrilled when they toured our community.

CHAIRPERSON OPENED THE PUBLIC HEARING

There was no one in the audience to speak in opposition.

CHAIRPERSON CLOSED THE PUBLIC HEARING
