AUTHORIZATION TO PROCEED WITH ACQUISITION OF THE NECESSARY RIGHT-OF-WAY AND EASEMENTS FOR THE EAST INDIANOLA AVENUE WIDENING PROJECT BY GIFT, NEGOTIATION, OR EMINENT DOMAIN

WHEREAS, on July 25, 2005, by Roll Call No. 05-1773, City Council approved the professional services agreement between the City of Des Moines and Snyder & Associates, Inc., for engineering services in conjunction with the East Indianola Avenue Corridor Study; and

WHEREAS, on October 8, 2007, by Roll Call No. 07-1994, City Council (1) approved the East Indianola Avenue Corridor Study, and (2) approved the professional services agreement with Snyder & Associates, Inc. (David Moeller, P.E., President, 501 SW Oralabor Road, Ankeny, Iowa 50021), for the East Indianola Avenue Roadway Design, total not to exceed \$988,908.00; and

WHEREAS, after the design is completed and right-of-way needs are determined, the proposed Fair Market Value of the property interests to be acquired will be submitted to the City Council or the City Manager, as applicable, for approval and authorization to proceed with the acquisitions; and

WHEREAS, public hearings have been set pursuant to the Iowa Code for authorization of right-of-way acquisition on agricultural land (Iowa Code Section 6B.2A) and of acquisition of property for recreational trail purposes (Iowa Code Section 6B.2D), and City Council must separately approve authorization to proceed with acquisition for the remainder of the right-of-way and easement needs for the East Indianola Avenue Widening Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

- 1. That the City of Des Moines Real Estate Division be and is hereby authorized to proceed with the necessary activities and negotiations to acquire by gift, negotiation, or condemnation the necessary property interests, other than those interests located on agricultural land or to be acquired for recreational trail purposes, for construction of the East Indianola Avenue Widening Project, subject to approval by this Council, or approval of the City Manager in accordance with Section 2-201 (c) and (d), of the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, as appropriate.
- 2. That the properties will be acquired in accordance with the guidelines of 49 CFR Part 24 of the Uniform Relocation and Real Property Acquisition Act, as revised, and that relocation assistance is hereby authorized.
- 3. That the Fair Market Value of these parcels will be approved in accordance with established City policy. If the property owners agree to convey the property to the City in an amount based on the established fair market value, including an approved administrative settlement, or if a condemnation


