FROM : Bob Gieber, President of the Carpenter Neighbors

I am writing to urge the Des Moines City Council not to renew the liquor license for the convenience store located at 2121 University Avenue. The store is operated by Tony Dassan.

This business has been a problem for the Carpenter, Drake Park and Drake neighborhoods ever since it opened, and the owner has not cooperated with the police and neighborhoods in solving the issues that we have raised. The business is a magnet for prostitutes, panhandlers and loiterers, and the owner has refused to take basic measures to prevent or lessen these activities.

This business has also caused problems for neighboring businesses, and people living near the store have complained about the noise and litter from Mr. Dassan's customers.

Mr. Dassan at first assured the neighborhoods that he would not sell hard liquor, only beer, and now he sells mainly hard liquor. He was even selling individual cigarettes.

Since Mr. Dassan has chosen to ignore the concerns of the neighborhoods, we urge you to deny his liquor license renewal.

Your cooperation will be much appreciated in this matter.
