



STAFF REPORT

I. GENERAL INFORMATION

- Purpose of Request: The City Council on August 9, 2010, initiated the renaming of the segment of Stanton Avenue to Scout Trail per request from the Boy Scouts of America Mid-lowa Council.
- 2. Size of Site: Approximately 500 lineal feet.
- 3. Existing Land Use (site): Stanton Avenue.
- 4. Adjacent Land Use and Zoning:

North - "PBP" - Use is undeveloped land within Airport Industrial Park PBP.
```

South – "C-2" – Use is undeveloped land.

- 4. General Neighborhood/Area Land Uses: The subject property is located along the western city limits east of Highway 28 and is surrounded primarily undeveloped land.
- 5. Applicable Recognized Neighborhood(s): Southwestern Hills Neighborhood.
- 6. Relevant Zoning History: N/A.
- 7. Applicable Regulations: The Commission reviews all proposed street name changes to determine whether they will have any impact on the essential public good. The recommendation of the Commission is forwarded to the City Council.

II. ADDITIONAL APPLICABLE INFORMATION

1. Street System: The subject section of street is surrounded by undeveloped land. The proposed name change will have no impact on traffic or postal delivery to adjoining properties. However, staff believes the renaming of the street segment would create inconsistency for way finding due to potential future development of the land and southwest connector. Furthermore, staff believes the overall integrity of the street naming system could be jeopardized by similar requests. Staff recommends an honorary naming of the street segment to Scout Trail.

SUMMARY OF DISCUSSION

Erik Lundy presented staff report and recommendation.

<u>Dann Flaherty</u> asked what are the future plans for connecting Stanton Avenue to anything to the east/west.

<u>Erik Lundy</u> stated it is committed for purposes of future right-of-way for the southwest connector. This segment of Stanton Avenue would connect from 63rd Street to the Southwest Connector.

JoAnne Corigliano asked what is the reason staff is thinking it is critical to way finding.

<u>Erik Lundy</u> stated that way finding is set up on a grid system of north, south, east, and west street names and it is ordinal based on where the streets are relative to each other.

Bob Hopper, CEO of Mid Iowa Council Boy Scouts of America, 1659 E. Euclid Avenue stated part of their council's strategic plan for a number of years is to relocate that office, and to build a new office and program center. This property on 63rd Street is almost 16 acres and their desire is to develop offices, a community center, and urban camp. Their vision includes a soccer field, pond, outdoor amphitheater, trails, and education areas. The wing that is designated for training will accommodate up to 200 people and will be made available to the community at-large, free of charge. Working with SVPA, it seemed like a natural idea to look at Stanton Avenue with the possibility of requesting a name change. It would be a very nice thing, to name that small section of road "Scout Trail". They would be able to tell their community that the new scout center is at the corner of 63rd & Scout Trail.

Brian Millard asked if the applicant anticipates Scout Trail ending up as a cul-de-sac in that area.

<u>Bob Hopper</u> stated that his understanding the street will connect from 63rd Street to the Southwest Connector.

JoAnne Corigliano asked if the applicant has already bought the property on 63rd Street.

<u>Bob Hopper</u> stated yes they have, they purchased it from Cornerstone Church in 2008. They anticipate moving dirt this November.

CHAIRPERSON OPENED THE PUBLIC HEARING

There was no one to speak in opposition of applicant's request

CHAIRPERSON CLOSED THE PUBLIC HEARING

<u>Brian Millard</u> stated that he disagreed with staff and recommended to formally name the street Scout Trail.

JoAnne Corigliano stated that she agreed with Brian Millard.

Kent Sovern stated that he concurred with Brian Millard.

<u>Ted Irvine</u> stated that he agrees with Brian Millard and thinks the segment of Stanton Avenue to Scout Trail should be permanent.

COMMISSION ACTION

<u>Brian Millard</u> moved to recommend formally renaming the subject segment of Stanton Avenue to Scout Trail.

Motion passed 10-0.
