

AGENDA HEADING:

Amending Chapter 74 of the City Code for bicycle rental fees and charges.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of proposed fee change for Gray's Lake Park Bicycle Rentals.

FISCAL IMPACT:

<u>Amount:</u> Staff projects that by reducing rental fees there will be an increase of total rentals which will increase net revenue.

<u>Funding Source</u>: The funding impact of the above recommendation will be provided from bicycle rental users at Gray's Lake Park and deposited into FY2010-2011 operating budget, GE001 PKS100104, page 198.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

During 2010, the City of Des Moines Parks and Recreation Department contracted with Bike World to provide rental bikes from May 24th through the conclusion of the concession season, October 3rd, with an option to renew for one (1), three (3) year period upon mutual agreement of both parties.

In 2010, 241 bicycles were rented. Revenue received from bike rentals totaled \$4,963; income was split between the City and Bike World at \$2,481 each. Of the 241 rentals, 199 rentals were in the category of rentals affected by the proposed fee reduction. Assuming rental numbers stay the same in 2011 as they were in 2010, there would be a \$995 loss of revenue. However, on-site staff frequently received comments from lake patrons noting interest in renting bikes by the hour and renting a road bike for a half day both of which were too expensive particularly for families. Based on this feedback and the fact that in the past the department has experienced an increase in the number of renters and net revenue when lowering fees, the following changes are recommended:

- Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, is hereby amended by adding and enacting a new Section 74-177 and repealing Section 74-184(c), relating to bike and related equipment rental fees, as follows:
