ACCEPTING PROPOSAL FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FROM SEBESTA BLOMBERG & ASSOCIATES INC. TO CONDUCT AN ENERGY USE ANALYSIS AND PLAN FOR CERTAIN BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES IN THE CITY OF DES MOINES UNDER THE ECO CORE DOWNTOWN SUSTAINABILITY STUDY AND APPROVING CONTRACT FOR SAME IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$122,500

WHEREAS, Congress passed the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) or 2009, which the President signed into law on February 17, 2009, to stimulate the economy and create jobs; and

WHEREAS, ARRA included \$3.2 billion in funding for the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) Program authorized in Title V, Subtitle E of the Energy Independence and Security Act (EISA) and signed into law on December 19, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines, Iowa was awarded EECBG funding under contract award DE-SC0003333, which authorized the Eco Core Downtown Sustainability Study; and

WHEREAS, The Eco Core Downtown Sustainability Study is intended to provide participating building owners with useful, practical information on ways to improve the energy performance of their buildings, resulting in improvements than can offer substantial abilities to reduce operation and maintenance costs, increase occupancy rates and increase building valuation. It is reasoned that new investment in the existing downtown office building stock can lead to increased environmental sustainability as well as enhanced competiveness for the improved spaces within the City of Des Moines; and

WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines intends to comply with all agreed upon contractual requirements of ARRA, the EECBG program and other federal and state law; and

WHEREAS, on February 2, 2011, a Request for Proposal (RFP) V11-056 to conduct an Energy Usage and Analysis and Plan was issued by the Procurement Division of the Finance Department; and

WHEREAS, the Procurement Administrator solicited proposals by advertising and mailing RFP V11-056 to 5 potential proposers with 4 proposals received; and

WHEREAS, an Evaluation and Selection Committee has reviewed the proposals and has recommended that a contract for such services be awarded to Sebesta Blomberg & Associates Inc., d/b/a Sebesta Blomberg, 2381 Rosegate, Roseville, MN 5511, Richard Ney, Principal-in-Charge, 305 Second Street SE, Suite 210, Cedar Rapids, IA 52401; and
