AN ORDINANCE vacating the north/south alley right-of-way located in the block south of Mulberry Street and west of vacated 13<sup>th</sup> Street.

WHEREAS, all prior requirements of law pertaining to the vacation of public right-of-way have been fully observed; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the public right-of-way herein described be vacated;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Sec. 1. That the north/south alley right-of-way located in the block south of Mulberry Street and west of vacated 13<sup>th</sup> Street, more specifically described as follows, be and is hereby vacated.

ALL OF THE NORTH/SOUTH ALLEY RIGHT-OF-WAY LYING WEST OF AND ADJOINING LOTS 1, 2 AND 10, AND LYING WEST OF AND ADJOINING THE VACATED EAST/WEST ALLEY RIGHT-OF-WAY LYING SOUTH OF AND ADJOINING SAID LOT 2, ALL IN BLOCK 33, KEENE & POINDEXTER'S ADDITION TO FORT DES MOINES, AN OFFICIAL PLAT, ALL NOW INCLUDED IN AND FORMING A PART OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, POLK COUNTY, IOWA.

- Sec. 2. The City of Des Moines hereby reserves an easement upon the property described above for the continued use and maintenance of any utilities now in place, with the right of entry for servicing same.
- Sec. 3. That the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause certified copies of this ordinance and proof of publication thereof together with proof of publication of the notice of the public hearing on this matter to be properly filed in the office of the Recorder of Polk County, Iowa.
- Sec. 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
