RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION BOARD'S RECOMMENDATION OF CHARTER STATUS FOR THE MERLE HAY NEIGHBORHOOD EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2012

WHEREAS, the Neighborhood Revitalization Program requires that all participating neighborhoods be evaluated every several years to measure progress towards completion of neighborhood plan goals before graduating to Charter Neighborhood status; and,

WHEREAS, the Community Development Department has worked with the Neighborhood Revitalization Board to create a process to evaluate the neighborhoods; and,

WHEREAS, the evaluation of the Merle Neighborhood consisted of a review of the neighborhood's plan that focused on five primary areas of City involvement: land use/zoning, housing, commercial, community enhancements, and physical environment; and,

WHEREAS, the Neighborhood Revitalization Board invited the Merle Hay Neighborhood Association to attend its April 6, 2011 meeting to give feedback regarding its evaluation and any other issues the neighborhood wanted to discuss; and,

WHEREAS, at its April 6, 2011 meeting, the Neighborhood Revitalization Board approved the staff recommendation to reclassify Merle Hay as a Charter Neighborhood,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that:

- 1. Merle Hay Neighborhood shall be reclassified as a Charter Neighborhood effective January 1, 2012.
- 2. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this action with attachments to the Polk County Board of Supervisors.

RE: Merle Hay Neighborhood Plan Evaluation

On April 6, 2011, the Neighborhood Revitalization Board approved a motion to recommend to the City Council that the Merle Hay and South Park Neighborhoods graduate to Charter Status as of January 1, 2012.

Substantial progress has been made toward completing the Merle Hay Neighborhood Plan goals. The City has invested over \$1.4 million in the neighborhood to improve the infrastructure in the area. In addition, the Merle Hay Neighborhood has generated over 220 NFC loans, which have invested over \$10 million into the neighborhood housing stock, and significant progress has been made toward implementing other aspects of the neighborhood plan.

Therefore, the Board recommends graduating the Merle Hay Neighborhood to Charter Status as of January 1, 2012.
