RE: South Park Neighborhood Plan Evaluation

On April 6, 2011, the Neighborhood Revitalization Board approved a motion to recommend to the City Council that the Merle Hay and South Park Neighborhoods graduate to Charter Status as of January 1, 2012.

Substantial progress has been made toward completing the South Park Neighborhood Plan goals. The South Park Neighborhood Association used the neighborhood planning process to significantly improve the capacity of their neighborhood organization. In addition, over \$700,000 was invested by the City to improve the neighborhood infrastructure, included utilizing CDBG to enhance a school walk route in the neighborhood, along with several other visible improvements in the area.

Therefore, the Board recommends graduating the South Park Neighborhood to Charter Status as of January 1, 2012.
