## APPROVAL OF AGREEMENT FOR PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT BOOTH AT 2011 DES MOINES ARTS FESTIVAL

WHEREAS, the Park and Recreation department desires to promote the City of Des Moines recreational programs at the Des Moines Arts Festival, which will be held on June 24, 25 and 25, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Des Moines Arts festival, a non-profit organization, requires organizations to execute an agreement, a copy of which is on file in the City Clerk's Office, in order to operate a booth during the Des Moines Arts Festival; and

WHEREAS, such agreement requires that the City of Des Moines provide liability insurance coverage, which may be satisfied by the City's self-insurance program, and to indemnify the Des Moines Arts festival, its sponsors, staff and volunteers harmless from any claim or cause of action arising out of or in connection with the acts or omissions of the City operating its booth during the festival, including reasonable attorney fees.

NOW. THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa that the above described agreement for operation of a booth at the Des Moines Arts Festival by the Park and Recreation Department, which is on file with the City Clerk's Office, is hereby approved and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to sign on behalf of the City and the City Clerk is directed to attest to his signature.
