APPROVE AND AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO SIGN MAJOR AMENDMENT #11 OF THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT HOUSING DISASTER RECOVERY (CDBG-DR) FUND CONTRACT WITH IOWA DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT—IDED (CONTRACT NUMBER 08-DHR-009).

WHEREAS, the Iowa Department of Economic Development (IDED) is administering the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Disaster Recovery Funds program to assist with flood recovery per a statewide allocation plan approved by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

WHEREAS, IDED and the City of Des Moines previously entered into a Contract (the “Contract”) pursuant to which IDED granted funds to the City of Des Moines to aid in recovery from the natural disasters of 2008; and

WHEREAS, Major Amendment #11 (attached as Exhibit A) adjusts the budget of the existing contract to reflect the actual amount of funds spent on homeowner and rental repair; and


WHEREAS, the budget is being adjusted from \$3,598,805 to \$2,578,254. The difference in the budgets will be recaptured by the Iowa Department of Economic Development and reallocated to other eligible activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the Major Amendment #11 of the Community Development Block Grant Housing Disaster Recovery Fund Contract with Iowa Department of Economic Development (Contract Number 08-DHR-209), attached hereto, be approved and the Mayor is authorized to sign the amendment.



The Iowa Department of Economic Development (IDED) hereby amends the above referenced Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program contract by changing the contract amount of \$3,598,805 to \$2,578,264.
