RESOLUTION CLOSING HEARING ON THE VACATION AND LEASE OF A PORTION OF THE PUBLIC SIDEWALK ADJOINING MICKEY'S IRISH PUB AT 206 3rd STREET FOR A SIDEWALK CAFE, AND APPROVING SAME

- 2. There is no public need for the right-of-way proposed to be vacated and the public would not be inconvenienced by reason of the vacation of the portion of Court Avenue adjoining 206 3rd Street, more specifically described as follows:

The North 6.55 feet of the Court Avenue right-of-way lying South of and adjoining that part of the South 1/2 of Lot 8 in Block 24, Original Town of Fort Des Moines, an Official Plat, being described as Parcel G of the Plat of Survey filed January 14, 1999, in Book 8116, Page 619, in the Office of the Polk County Recorder, all now included in and forming a part of the City of Des Moines.
