APPROVAL OF PUBLIC EVENT BANNER AT THE CIVIC CENTER OF GREATER DES MOINES

WHEREAS, the City Council has received the accompanying request from Julie Houghton, Executive Assistant, for the Civic Center of Greater Des Moines, seeking approval to install a 40' wide by 40' high banner on the north wall of the Civic Center announcing the return of the Broadway musical Wicked; and,

WHEREAS, Section 134-1276(i)(1)(d) provides that temporary signs which satisfy the following conditions are allowed in any zoning district:

Such signs advertising a public event providing that specific approval is granted under regulations established by the city council.

WHEREAS, the Civic Center of Greater Des Moines is a non-profit, 501.c.3 performing arts center which provides substantial cultural and educational benefits to the citizens of the City of Des Moines; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the Civic Center of Greater Des Moines is hereby granted approval to install the banner described above from October 25th through December 5, 2011.

Ladies and Gentlemen:

Please consider the Civic Center's request to place a temporary banner on the North side of the Civic Center building in association with the Des Moines presentation of *Wicked*. The large banner is similar to those which were hung in the past: in 2009 for *Wicked* and in 2006 and 2010 for *The Lion King*. The proposed location is shown in the attached diagram. Our plan is to install the 40' x 40' banner on Thursday, October 27 and keep it in place until *Wicked*'s appearance ends in early December.

Since its launch, *Wicked* has been one of the most popular Broadway shows not only in New York but throughout the country. We believe that this banner will serve as a civic "welcome" for the many patrons who will visit the downtown area during the run.


