WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines has been awarded an additional \$18,424 from the FY2010 Methamphetamine Drug Hot Spots Grant Program from the Iowa Governor's Office of Drug Control Policy for a total of \$50,000; and,

WHEREAS, the grant period has been extended from July 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011 to July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012; and,

WHEREAS, the revised grant will provide an additional \$18,424 for overtime related to methamphetamine interdiction activities; and,

WHEREAS, there is no match requirement for this grant;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the FY2010 Methamphetamine Drug Hot Spots Grant Program Revised Award by the U.S. Department of Justice through the Iowa Governor's Office of Drug Control Policy is hereby approved, with the Mayor authorized to sign the award document on behalf of the City, with the City Clerk to attest to the mayor's signature, and the City Manager or his designee is directed to take any and all steps necessary to timely file and implement the grant award document.
