Dear Mayor Cownie and Honorable City Council Members:

On behalf of the River Bend Neighborhood Association, I am writing to request that the second and third hearings regarding the establishment of the River Bend Local Historic District be waived.

The River Bend Neighborhood Association has been working on the local historic district initiative for over 18 months and secured considerable support. The Association's petition drive exceeded the support required by City Code, including support from over 70% of owner-occupied properties within the proposed district. The Historic Preservation and Plan and Zoning Commissions voted unanimously in support of the designation, with no public opposition at the last public hearing on December 15, 2011.

In light of this considerable effort over the last 18 months and significant support of property owners in the proposed district, I respectfully ask that the second and third hearings be waived.
