

The ordinance repeals all of current city code chapter 22 relating to the airport board, airport zoning and the airport authority and at the same time renumbers and reenacts the ordinances creating the authority and regulating airport zoning, without changing them except to correct cross references. The ordinance further clarifies that violators of city ordinances that apply on the airport and violators of airport regulations may be prosecuted as if they had violated the city code.

HONORABLE MAYOR AND MEMBERS

Re: Re: Amending City Code for Airport Authority

With the creation of the Des Moines Airport Authority on November 1, 2011, and the transfer of the Des Moines International Airport to the Authority, there are several sections of the city code that need to be repealed or updated for housekeeping purposes. On the November 19, 2012 Council agenda is a proposed ordinance that repeals or amends all sections that refer to the now defunct Airport Board and renumbers the sections that deal with the Authority and airport zoning. Procedurally, the ordinance repeals all of current city code chapter 22 relating to the airport board, airport zoning and the airport authority and at the same time renumbers and reenacts the ordinances creating the authority and regulating airport zoning, without changing them except to correct cross references. Other than that, the amendments clarify that violators of city ordinances that apply on the airport and violators of airport regulations may be prosecuted as if they had violated the city code.
