WHEREAS, on August 27, 2012, by Roll Call No. 12-1328, City Council approved Department of Transportation Conditional and Preliminary Term Sheet for the TIGER Discretionary Grant for the Southeast Connector Project between SE 14<sup>th</sup> Street and SE 30<sup>th</sup> Street, which included an interim milestone of December 2012 for the Norfolk Southern Railway Company ("NSR") agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City's Real Estate Division and NSR have negotiated the terms of a Contract of Purchase for the partial fee acquisitions, temporary construction easements, permanent easement for roadway overpass and total fee acquisition of property owned by NSR for the Southeast Connector Project, and execution of this Contract will satisfy the deadline established by the above referenced Term Sheet; and

WHEREAS, the City's Real Estate Division suggests the amount listed below as fair market value for said property interests, based on independent appraisals and negotiated settlement with NSR.
