AN ORDINANCE to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, is hereby amended by amending Section 114-1541, relating to traffic and vehicle regulations.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, is hereby amended by amending Section 114-1541 relating to traffic and vehicle regulations, as follows:

Sec. 114-1541. Grand Avenue.

Grand Avenue, on the north side, at a point 350 feet east of Second Avenue, pedestrian signal.

Grand Avenue, on the north side, at a point east side of Polk Boulevard, pedestrian signal.

Grand Avenue, on the south side, at a point 188 feet east of Forty-fourth Street, school signal.

Grand Avenue, on the north side, at a point 1,240 feet east of Fifty-sixth Street, school signal.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
