Re: Naming of Greenwood Wading Pool Shelter

Dear Mayor and City Council Members:

In December of last year, Ben Page and I discussed my desire to donate funds towards a project in my neighborhood park, Greenwood Park, in honor of my late son, Jay Spence.

As a past Park and Recreation Board member and one of the founding directors of Des Moines Park and Recreation Foundation, I understand how important parks are to our city neighborhoods. We lived close to Greenwood and Jay often visited the park while growing up in Des Moines. Later he became a successful photographer in Los Angeles but was killed in a car accident 10 years ago last month.

Ben spoke to me about an idea to improve the shelter by the wading pool and that funding would be needed to assist with the project.
