WHEREAS, on December 18, 2002, by Roll Call No. 02-3007, the City Council approved a Schedule of Fees for various City services, including permits issued by the Fire Department under authority of Chapter 46 of the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa; and

WHEREAS, an amended Schedule of Fees has been prepared for Council consideration and is recommended for adoption, which amended Schedule of Fees is appended hereto and is now on file in the office of the City Clerk.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa that the amended Schedule of Fees appended hereto is hereby approved and adopted.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to incorporate said amendment into the Schedule of Fees, and to maintain said amended Schedule of Fees, as amended, on file in the offices of the City Clerk for public reference, said amendment to become effective on September 1, 2014.
