APPROVAL OF CONTRACT AND BOND  
2014 CITY-WIDE PCC PAVEMENT RESTORATION PROGRAM  
\$417,950.00

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA: That the contract and bond, in the amount of \$417,950.00, executed by T K Concrete Inc., Tony J. Ver Meer, President, 1608 Fifield Road, Pella, IA, 50219 dated June 9, 2014, for the construction of the following improvement:

2014 City-wide PCC Pavement Restoration Program, 06-2014-009

The improvement includes furnishing, placing, curing, sawing, and sealing PCC pavement patches of various thickness in a cooperative effort with the City of Des Moines, Public Works Department, at the following locations in Des Moines, Iowa:

- 48th Street from Bel Aire Road to Crestmoor Drive
- Shawnee Avenue from 42nd Street to 43rd Street
- Ohio Street from Indiana Avenue to College Avenue
- Madison Avenue from 14th Street to 12th Street
- E. Ovid Avenue from E. 38th Street to E. 42nd Street
- E. 35th Court from E. University Avenue to Garfield Avenue
- Grand Avenue from 59th Street to 62nd Street
- 59th Street from Grand Avenue to 100 feet north of Grand Avenue
- Grand Avenue from 56th Street to 58th Street
- 15th Street from Woodland Avenue to Center Street
- E. 29th Street from Maple Avenue (to west) to Maple Avenue (to east)
- Pioneer Road from S.E. 6th Street to S.E. 8th Street
- S.E. 17th Street from Glenwood Drive to King Avenue
- E. Glenwood Drive from S.E. 17th Street (to north) to S.E. 17th Street (to south)
- S.W. 7th Street from Watrous Avenue to Maish Avenue
- S.E. 8th Street from Hart Avenue to Porter Avenue
- S.E. 8th Street from E. Diehl Avenue to south of E. Diehl Avenue
- Indianola Avenue from U.S. 69 to asphalt east of U.S. 69

the same to be performed in accordance with the plans and specifications which have been heretofore approved by this Council, be and the same are hereby approved, subject to receipt of the contract, bond, and certificate of insurance acceptable to the Engineering and Legal Departments. The attached "Contractor's Anticipated DBE/TSB Utilization" shows the Contractor's efforts to solicit DBE/TSB Participation in accordance with the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise/Targeted Small Business (DBE/TSB) Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said contract on behalf of the City of Des Moines, subject to receipt of the contract, bond, and certificate of insurance acceptable to the Engineering and Legal Departments, and the City Clerk, be and is hereby authorized and directed to attest to same. No contract shall be deemed to exist between the City of Des Moines and said Bidder until said contract has been executed by the Bidder, and shall have been approved by this Council and executed by the Mayor and attested to by the City Clerk.




