AN ORDINANCE to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, by amending Sections 74-176, 74-182, 74-183, 74-184, 74-185, 74-186 and 74-187, relating to parks and recreation fees.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, is hereby amended by amending Sections 74-176, 74-182, 74-183, 74-184, 74-185, 74-186 and 74-187 relating to parks and recreation fees, as follows:

Sec. 74-176. Ball diamonds, tennis, volleyball court and soccer fields.

- (a) Scope. Fees for use of city ball diamonds, volleyball courts and soccer fields and for tennis shall be as provided in this section.
- (b) Ball diamonds. Fees for use of ball diamonds for private use at Carney, Chesterfield, Savage, Cownie Baseball Park and Greater Des Moines Softball Park. No charge for educational institutions.
- (c) *Ball diamonds*. Fees for use of ball diamonds for private use at Carney, Chesterfield, Savage, Cownie Baseball Park and Greater Des Moines Softball Park, shall be as follows:
 - (1) Tournament Field Rental \$65.00\\$100.00 per field per day at Greater Des Moines Softball Park in calendar year 2015, \$110.00 in 2017, and \$120.00 in 2019, and \$75.00 per field per day at Carney Softball Park in calendar year 2015, \$85.00 in 2017 and \$95.00 in 2019 Tournament fee includes lining and chalking every three games.
 - (2) Tournament Field Rental after 5:00 p.m. \$35.00 per field per day.
 - (3) Tournament Admission fees \$50.00 per team for tournament rentals at baseball diamonds.
 - (34) Tournament fees include lining and chalking every three games. Each additional line and chalk \$15.00 per field per lining.
 - (45) Rental for Games and Practices (Leagues): -\$15.00 per hour before 6:00 p.m.

- (8) Rental for Practices (Neighborhood Use) \$12.00 per hour after 6:00 p.m.
 - Neighborhood Use is defined as use by non-profit or non-commercial organization or persons for practices scheduled and paid for by the team using the field.
- (9) Rental for Games and Practices (Adult Baseball) \$6.00 per hour before 6:00 p.m.
- (10) Rental for Games and Practices (Adult Baseball) \$12.00 per hour after 6:00 p.m.
 - Adult Baseball is defined as an independent adult league using Birdland Baseball Field.
- (d) Soccer park field. Rental fees for the soccer park shall be as follows:
 - (1) Tournament (per field per day/minimum of four fields) \$120.00:

Sec. 74-182. Lodge, park shelter and other park rentals.

Fees for lodges, park shelter and other park rentals shall be as follows:

- (1) Sylvan Theater
 - a. Fee Based Event \$750.00 for 1/2 day (sunrise to 1:00 or 2:00 to sunset)
 - b. Weddings/Private Parties \$300.00 first two hours (minimum) \$150.00 each additional hour
- (2) Garden reservation fee. For one-hour session, must specify garden area:
 - a. Clare and Miles Mills Rose Garden: \$300.00 first two hours (minimum) \$150.00 each additional hour
 - b. Union Formal Garden: \$15.00
- (3) Enclosed Shelters. Unless otherwise specified, each rental session is for an eleven hour block. No rentals on Thanksgiving day and Christmas day.
 - a. Enclosed Shelters (Greenwood, Pioneer, MacRae and Union): \$80.00 per session Monday-Thursday and \$100.00 per session on Friday, Saturday, Sunday and holidays per session.

- b. *Grandview Enclosed:* \$160.00 Monday through Thursday per session and \$200.00 Friday, Saturday, Sunday and holidays per session.
- c. Ding Darling Enclosed: \$200.00 per session Monday-Thursday and \$240.00 per session on Friday, Saturday, Sunday and holidays per session.
- d. *Martin Luther King Jr. Shelter* \$35.00 per hour (two hour minimum requirement) \$20 for each hour thereafter
- e. *Open air shelters* with the exception of shelters with a capacity of over 100 people (reserved for only one group per day):- \$30.00\$40.00
 - 1. Shelters with capacity of over 100 people may be reserved in two time blocks (10:00 a.m. 3:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. 9:00 p.m.) per day: \$60 per session.
 - 2. Rental rates for all shelters double on holidays.
- (4) Stewart Square Park and Stage. Each rental session is for a nine hour block (reserved for only one group per day): \$30.00
- (5) Gray's Lake Park.
 - a. Overlook Terrace Rental \$200.00 per 3 hour block
 - b. Designated open space rental \$250.00 per half day (6 hours)
 - c. Event parking (south of Terrace) \$50.00 for three hours increments

- (10) Wading pool rental: \$25.00 per hour (minimum three hours)
- (11) Robert D. Ray *Asian Garden*: \$500.00 per 4 hour block, \$100 for each additional hour.
- (12) Park field permit: \$1.00 per hour per field effective January 15, 2014, \$2.00 per hour per field effective January 1, 2015, \$3.00 per hour per field effective January 1, 2016, \$4.00 per hour per field effective January 1, 2017, \$5.00 per hour per field effective January 1, 2018 (park and recreation director has no authority to waive).
- (13) Disc golf tournament: \$100.00 for recreational tournaments.

Sec. 74-187. Set program fees and authority to make temporary fee adjustments.

Recreation program fees, administrative fees for processing refunds, and customer requested program schedule changes that are not related to admissions or rental charges established in this section shall be set by the park and recreation director taking into consideration market conditions and direct expenses related to said program offerings. Fees as determined in sections 74-176 through 74-186, and section 34-69 of this code may be changed at the discretion of the park and recreation director upon the approval of the city manager—for engaging in special projects, programs or promotions that justify such change, including reduced fees to provide access to park and recreation programs and facilities to low income residents, organizations solely or primarily devoted to serving low income individuals, or not-for-profit agencies. The park and recreation director shall report annually in January to the park and recreation board and city manager on changed fees for the preceding year's activities which were approved by the director.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
