ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, is amended by adding and enacting a new Section 62-43, relating to the Human Rights Commission charging and collecting fair housing training fees.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by

Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, is hereby amended adding and

enacting a new Section 62-43, relating to the Human Rights Commission charging and collecting fair

housing training fees, as follows:

Sec. 62-43. Fair Housing Training Fees.

The commission, or its director or his or her designee, is authorized to charge and collect a fee for training persons who are not residents of the City of Des Moines concerning the subject of fair housing. The fee shall be in the amount set in the schedule of fees adopted by the city council by resolution.

Secs. 62-4<u>43</u>—62-70. Reserved.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and

publication as provided by law.
