WHEREAS, on September 8, 2014, by Resolution No. 14-1418, the City Council referred the issue of wage protection to the City Manager and Legal Department for recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the City Council referred the matter to staff as a result of complaints that a contractor hired by the city had not complied with laws pertaining to payment of wages to contractor's employees; and

WHEREAS, staff proposes the inclusion of the attached certification entitled "Certification on Compliance with Wage Payment Laws" in written solicitations for City construction projects, excluding emergency solicitations or solicitations where such inclusion would be a violation of any federal or state laws or regulations.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DES MOINES, IOWA:
