

Reference is hereby made to the following proposed ordinance to be considered at the Des Moines City Council meeting on February 9, 2015 (the "Proposed Ordinance"):

VACATION OF A PORTION OF LOCUST STREET RIGHT-OF-WAY ADJOINING 400 LOCUST STREET AND A PERMANENT EASEMENT WITH THE DES MOINES AREA REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY FOR PLACEMENT OF A BUS SHELTER ON THE VACATED CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY

The Des Moines Area Regional Transit Authority ("DART") hereby requests that the Des Moines City Council waive the requirement that, in accordance with the Iowa Code, the Proposed Ordinance be considered and voted on for passage at two City Council meetings prior to the meeting at which the Proposed Ordinance is to be passed. DART hereby requests a waiver of such requirement so that the construction and operation of the bus shelter to be located on the vacated right-of-way, as referenced in the Proposed Ordinance, can commence as soon as possible.
