
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Staff received a request from residents at 5401 SW 9th Street and 5400 SW 8th Street that the corner clearance on the north side of Kenyon Avenue east of SW 9th Street be extended to cover times outside of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The existing corner clearance is 150 feet east of SW 9th Street and covers the times from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. only. This was to provide the necessary clearance at the corner and maintain ability for large trucks at the adjacent printing company to park in that area outside of the main daily peak hours. The printing company has since moved out of the building, and the building has been unoccupied for some time.

Staff reviewed this request and recommended that if the hours were to be changed to cover 24-hours per day, the corner clearance should be reduced to 100 feet to minimize the impact on the former printing company property while still providing for proper corner clearance. Both residents were in support of this request. At their February 10, 2015 meeting, the Traffic Safety Committee concurred with staff recommendation. The following code revisions will put this change into effect.

Sec. 114-3365. Kenyon Avenue--South Union Street to Fleur Drive.

Kenyon Avenue, on the north side, from Southwest Ninth Street to a point 150 100 feet east thereof, no parking any time 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, by amending Section 114-3365, relating to traffic and vehicle regulations.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, is hereby amended by amending Section 114-3365 relating to traffic and vehicle regulations, as follows:

Sec. 114-3365. Kenyon Avenue-South Union Street to Fleur Drive.

Kenyon Avenue, on the south side, from South Union Street to Southwest Ninth Street, no parking any time.

Kenyon Avenue, on the south side, from Southwest Ninth Street to a point 400 feet west thereof, no parking any time.

Kenyon Avenue, on the south side, from a point 370 feet west of Southwest Tenth Street to a point 70 feet west thereof, no parking any time.

Kenyon Avenue, on the north side, from South Union Street to a point 50 feet west thereof, no parking any time.

Kenyon Avenue, on the north side, from Southwest Ninth Street to a point 150 100 feet east thereof, no parking any time. 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Kenyon Avenue, on the north side, from Southwest Ninth Street to Fleur Drive, no parking any time.

Kenyon Avenue, on the south side, from Southwest Twentieth Street to Fleur Drive, no parking any time.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
