APPROVAL OF 2015 FINAL BUDGET ALLOCATIONS FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM, HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP (HOME) PROGRAM, AND EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANT (ESG) PROGRAM FUNDING FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD)

WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines receives annual entitlement funding for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, the Home Investment Partnership (HOME) Program and the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) Program from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

WHEREAS, on November 3, 2014, by Roll Call No. 14-1730, it was duly resolved by the Des Moines City Council to approve the 2015 Action Plan preliminary budget estimates of the Des Moines Five-Year (2015 – 2019) Strategy of the Des Moines HUD Consolidated Plan, as directed by HUD, and to delay submission to the Regional Office until publication of the final 2015 appropriations; and

WHEREAS, HUD published the final 2015 appropriations for CDBG, HOME and ESG funding for the entitlement cities on February 10, 2015, and the City's 2015 Action allocations must now be submitted to HUD.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the 2015 Action Plan allocations for the CDBG, HOME and ESG programs, as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto, are hereby approved, and the City Manager, or his designee, is authorized and directed to submit the 2015 Action Plan allocations to HUD and to take all necessary actions and to execute all forms, relevant documents and certifications for submittal to HUD.
