WHEREAS, the Police Department Homeland Security Bureau requested the Finance Department Procurement Division to order replacement bomb suits to be compatible with existing communication system equipment; and

WHEREAS, said bomb suits are available from MED-ENG, 103 Tulloch Drive, Ogdensburg, NY 13669, Scott O'Brien/President, the manufacturer and sole area wide distributor, at a total cost of \$193,104.00; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Code section 2-726 (a)(7) provides for a non-competitive procurement of goods and/or services that are of such a nature that they are the only goods and/or services which will fit and comply with the required use, or are an integral part of a total system so as to be uniquely compatible with existing city need, materials or equipment to be cost effective; and

WHEREAS, funding is available from HSP00014/Homeland Security EOD 2014 Grant; and

WHEREAS, the Procurement Administrator and the Police Department recommends approval of the purchase of replacement bomb suites;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Des Moines City Council hereby accepts and approves the non-competitive purchase of bomb suits from MED-ENG at a total cost of \$193,104.00.
