We attended the information meeting Sept. 21 and was advised to write a letter to you on our property at SE 14th & Hart 6001 + 6017 SE 14th for a proposed sidewalk.

Probably 10 to 15 people a day if that many would walk on the East side of SE 14th when there is a sidewalk on the West side. 210 feet of our property is vacant land and if a sidewalk is put in and it is sold they would probably be removing the new sidewalk to build. If we would pay for the sidewalk, do they refund our money?

To us and several people east of SE 14th would definitely rather have sewer lines instead of a sidewalk at present. The area was annexed into the city 50 some years ago and the only thing they have done to add city water and sewer would be nice better streets than sidewalks. If sidewalks are installed we have to maintain them and our taxes will increase. Just like they have some being annexed.
